Each one played a vital role in community life, providing vital spiritual comfort and guidance as well as serving as a venue for weddings, funerals, suppers and special events. Some small churches have since closed, but many are still in use. On August 25, from 12-3:30 p.m., 8 historic churches from Cumberland to DeSable will open their doors to the public.
