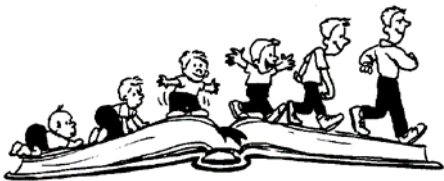
Our Zion Choirs will be resuming rehearsals in September and we would love to welcome any new members.
