CAMP KEIR UPDATE: Camp Keir is thrilled to announce that all of the new windows were installed in camp before the camping season began. The windows were also fitted with new curtain rods and curtains to cover the larger windows. Our signage was updated according to code, the furnace room had the required work completed and some wiring was changed with the fan in the kitchen. With all of the updates completed it meant that we did not have to hire a night staff person this year. We have now completed all of the work required to bring us up to code. We give thanks for all of the churches who helped us raise the funds needed to complete this important work. We are also pleased to report that we finished on budget and had a small surplus left over which was used to buy and install the new camp oil tank because our old one was set to expire in June. I know we had a enthusiastic staff who put in an awesome summer and all of our camper feedback has been excellent. Gift Card program

This program gives you the opportunity to purchase gift cards from Zion for a large number of retailers.

You purchase the cards at face value and Zion earns rebates with amounts varying from 2-7 %.

These cards can be used for your own every day needs such as groceries, gas and are great gifts not just at Christmas but for all special occasions as well.

We hold a bulk supply of a large number of retailers and cards for many other companies may be special ordered. Cards ordered by 9:30 on Monday will be available by Thursday. Cards may be paid for by cash cheques or debit cards. Visa and MasterCard may be used but this reduces the rebate by 1.75%.

We appreciate the participation of the individuals presently using this program and would encourage other members of the congregation to take part in this ongoing fundraiser.
