We hold a bulk supply of a large number of retailers and cards for many other companies may be special ordered. Cards ordered by 9:30 on Monday will be available by Thursday. Cards may be paid for by cash cheques or debit cards. Visa and MasterCard may be used but this reduces the rebate by 1.75%. We appreciate the participation of the individuals presently using this program and would encourage other members of the congregation to take part in this ongoing fundraiser.
