This program gives you the opportunity to purchase gift cards from Zion for a large number of retailers. You purchase the cards at face value and Zion earns rebates with amounts varying from 2-7 %. These cards can be used for your own every day needs such as groceries, gas and are great gifts not just at Christmas but for all special occasions as well. We hold a bulk supply of a large number of retailers and cards for many other companies may be special ordered. Cards ordered by 9:30 on Monday will be available by Thursday. Cards may be paid for by cash cheques or debit cards. Visa and MasterCard may be used but this reduces the rebate by 1.75%. We appreciate the participation of the individuals presently using this program and would encourage other members of the congregation to take part in this ongoing fundraiser. A copy of the retailers in our bulk supply and the company cards which we can special order are available in the office.

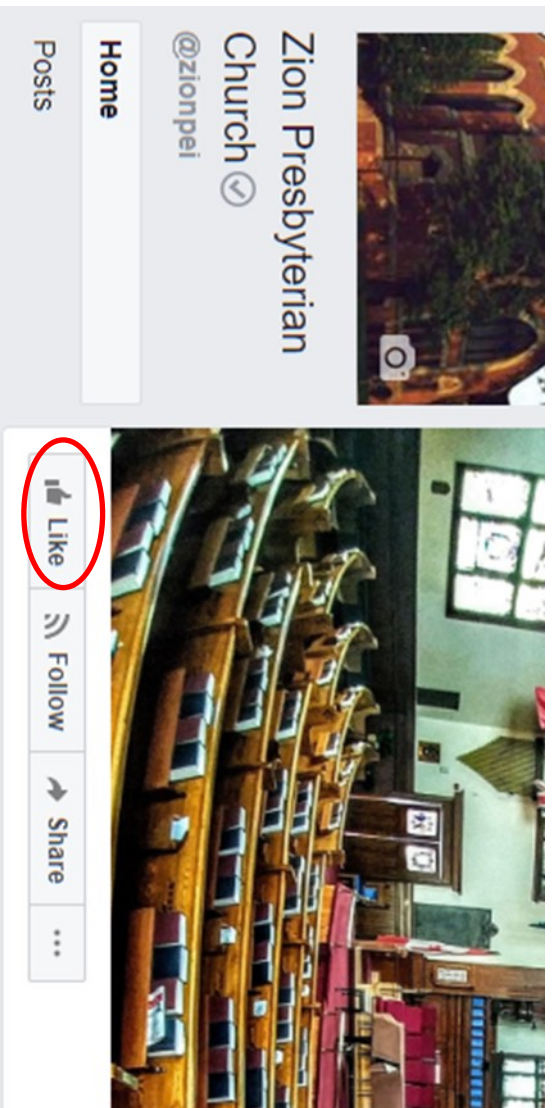
How do I find the page?
