December was our busiest month ever in Fundscrip sales. Total sales were slightly over \$20000 which generated revenue of approximately \$600. For example the purchase of \$200 in grocery cards and \$50 in gas cards would generate \$7. This done regularly every week would make around \$350 for Zion with no cost to you. We have a bulk supply of the main grocery and gas outlets as well as other cards such as Tim Hortons, Shoppers, Canadian Tire, Home Hardware, Walmart and many more. Special orders will be available within a week. A list of the bulk supply cards and the cards available by special order is available in the office. We certainly appreciate all who participated in this program through the year. Thank you to all the people who purchase on a regular basis and we welcome new participants at any time.
